1. Board Vacancy

Recurring Business:

1. Design Review(s)

Exterior changes/modifications must go through the Design Review process

- DRC Guidelines (as stated in CCRs) currently do not exist
 - Survey being reviewed to collect member feedback
 - Design Review Document to be first priority with new board members

4. Gate Updates

Gate is working correctly

• Guardian to improve back gate with fencing/pedestrian gate and remove large rocks used to eliminate cars from driving around the side gate(s) – later in the year

5. Common Area Maintenance

- Landscaping contract is even all year, can we pay less in dormant months?
- Aaron's Landscaping new sprinkler contact
 - Ted to contact Aaron about string not working

6. School Bus Stop(s)

Discussion on improving or moving the bus stop for safety purposes. Still getting many reports of unsafe activities

- Working with Transportation Department on bringing front bus stop into the community
 - Elementary Route: In through front gate, stop by mailboxes, left on 291st, right on 31st, out through back gate
 - o Middle/High Route: Same as before
 - o Parent parking: No parking on route
 - o Gate scheduled to be open during pickup and drop-off
- Steph to work with Connie to communicate
- BOARD PREVIOUSLY APPROVED: Us to build 2 bus shelters
 - Ted to get measurements to begin plans
 - o Back bus shelter will go in front of the existing light in the easement on the corner
 - LVB will have to get documentation for easement with current homeowner which will stay in place should they sell the property

7. Electrical Box Key

Company said we shouldn't have a key because it is the meter, but we need a key to turn off power to street lights. Cassie working on getting a key for her office.
